Winter Weather Closures

We certainly did get some snow recently, but are glad that we managed to stay open on that occasion. Below is a reminder of what to do in the event that the weather becomes so extreme that you are not certain whether we will be open or not.

Any decision to close the school is based on local conditions, the distance that staff have to travel, the safety of staff and children on site, and advice on travel and weather given out by the local media. We will always do our best to keep the school open but often our hand is forced by the circumstances.

School Meals Money: Spring Term

Thank you to all those parents who ensure their children's school meal accounts are kept in credit. Every parent is welcome to pay any amount 'up front' – the money will be retained on your child's meal account and will only be deducted when a meal is booked.

School Meals costs are as follows:-

Day	£2.15
Week	£10.75
Spring 1 st Half Term (to 9/2/18) ..	£60.20
Whole Spring Term (to 29/3/18) ..	£122.55

Cash or cheques (payable to 'HPSAJS') should be sent to school in an envelope marked with your child's name, base and how much is sent.

Please note that arrears should not build up beyond 24hrs i.e. if a meal is booked one day without payment, this should be paid for promptly the following morning.
